Purpose

- To assist the Development Coach develop and implement an effective training program for the Busselton Netball Association development squad in preparation for each Championship (Association and Regional).

- Qualifications - minimum Foundation Coaching Accreditation, working towards Developing Coaching Accreditation.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Some knowledge of and experience of netball coaching.
- Professionalism and confidentiality.
- Passion for the development of all players.

Typical time commitment

- Availability during selections in March and attendance at regular meetings.
- 1-3 hours weekly training plus planning from March until August.
- 2 x Championships (total 5 days).

Responsibilities and Duties

- Presence at squad selections.
- Assist the Development Coach to develop and follow a training program to prepare the squad for Championships, in consultation with Association Development Officer (ADO).
- Exercise duty of care for all athletes during training and games.
- Assist in the selection of athletes from squad to form team/s for participation in each

Championship, in liaison with Development Coach and ADO.

- Assist in the fair allocation of athletes from team to play in Championship games.
- Coach at all times in a responsible and professional manner abiding by the Coach's Code of Conduct
- In liaison with Development Coach, communicate with athletes, parents / caregivers and ADO in a timely, professional and transparent way.

Member Protection
